## Regular Meeting September 10, 2018 Page 1 of 2

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on September 10, 2018 at 7:00PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Treasurer Luckhardt, Clerk Marion and Trustee R Marion. Trustee R. Prehn was absent. Four other citizens were present.
3. Clerk Marion led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion supported by Mrs. R. Luckhardt that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Prehn moved, supported by Mrs. R. Luckhardt that the consent agenda be approved as presented.

  - e. Macon Rd Bridge- current plans are waiting final approval from the DEQ. At this time the Board is hoping the bridge will be completed by the spring of 2019.
