1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on June 8, 2015 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Luckhardt, Trustees R. Marion and R. Prehn. Seven other citizens were present.
3. Mr. R. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
 - a. Approve minutes from May 11th regular meeting
 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approve accounts payable for June in the amount of \$13,102.19
 - d. Approve June payroll in the amount \$5,521.36

6. Citizen Comments - Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. No citizen comments.
7. Supervisor's Report
 - a. Sherriff's Report- No major incidents.
 - b. Master Plan Meeting with Planning Commission to take place in June, date to follow.
 - c. Paxton- Supervisor Marion working with Paton Oil to obtain funds for the roads due to the high traffic from their trucks. Specific looking at Braun Road, current the township is scheduled to put approximately \$71,000 into the road this year. The Board also asked that Paxton have their drivers slow down when hauling in and out of the township.
 - d. 425 Agreement City of Saline- at this point the negotiating is still taking place for the property located on Michigan Ave.
 - e. My Way Trucking pulled their application prior to the public meeting therefore funds will be reimbursed to them.
 - f. Mike Callegari to receive a consulting fee for his work on the Limestone Project.
 - g. Treasurer Luckhardt to reinvest two of the townships current CD's, one will be renewed for six months the other for one year.

8. Trustees Report – Mr. Prehn reported on the Planning Commissions meeting from June. At this time the Board has denied Gentner’s request for a Special Use Permit, their request does not fall within our ordinance. A request from KB & K Landscaping for a Special Use permit will be reviewed by Doug Lewan once they have submitted a site plan. Doug Lewan will also review the request for a Special Use Permit from a Water Scape Company; currently the Board plans on granting the request as it falls under an agricultural nature. At this time residents who live on Macon Rd have been asked to supply the township Board with a letter stating the intent for their property. Currently the homeowners have a website stating that twelve adults and four children reside at property. Mr. Prehn was informed that the information on the site was incorrect however if correct this would be a violation of the township ordinance.
9. Zoning/Building Administrator Report – received a call from the Humane Society in regards to our ordinance on animals; they had received a complainant. One more falling structure has been taken down still working on a few.

11. Township Hall Manager Report – Luckhardt Plumbing to present to the Board at the July meeting an estimate for changing out the bathroom sinks/toilets and the kitchen sink.
