**Regular Meeting
August 10, 2015

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on August 10, 2015 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion and Trustee R. Marion. Treasurer Luckhardt and Trustee Prehn were absent. Eight other citizens were present.
3. Ms. Marion led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Ms. Marion that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Ms. Marion, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
 - a. Approve minutes from July 13th regular meeting
 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approve Accounts payable for August in the amount of \$8,527.08
 - d. Approve August payroll in the amount of \$5,521.36
 - e. Approve payment to Washtenaw County Road Commission in the amount of \$39,454.95 Brine/Limestone
 - f. Approve payment to Washtenaw County Equalization for Assessing 2015 in the amount of \$15,000
6. Citizen Comments - Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. Gretchen Driscoll presented Mrs. Judy Gordon with an award for her twenty-six years of service on the Saline Township Board. Two residences living on Mooreville Road addressed the Board in regards to their neighbors who appear to be living in their barn; this would be a violation of the townships ordinance. The Board gives Mr. Fred Lucas the Township attorney permission to prepare and file an affidavit in order to file suite. Moved by Mr. R. Marion and supported by Ms. Marion.
7. Supervisor's Report
 - a. Sherriff's Report- several traffic violations no major incidents.
 - b. Nuisance Ordinance to be addressed at the September meeting, Board currently looking at adopting one.
 - c. Paxton Oil was asked if they would be willing to donate towards roads; in return the Township received a check for \$5,000 from Paxton Oil.
 - d. Board Meeting time to be discussed at the September meeting. Being presented is a new start time of 7PM.
 - e. Plumbing Bid- moving forward with Luckhardt Plumbing to update the bathrooms and kitchen sink.
 - f. Dan Madigan who represents a caregiver/patient relationship group out of Ann Arbor addressed the Board in regards to opening up a Medical Marijuana Nursery in Saline Township. Fred Lucas, the township attorney has advised the Board that Mr. Madigan's request is in no way a violation of any of the

townships ordinances. Mr. Madigan will need to apply for a zoning compliance application.

- g. Saline Police received a call in regards to gun shoots coming from Saline Township; currently the township has no noise ordinance and the resident was in compliance with the law.
- h. Austin Road bridges to open by the end of August. Arkona Road Bridge by the end of fall and Hack Road by next spring.
- i. Dave Rhoads has purchased a piece of property on Maple Road/Saline Milan Road, which is located in both Saline Township (approximately 1+/- acres) and York Township (approximately 17 +/- acres). Mr. Rhoads hopes to develop a Nature Preserve. Surrounding cities and townships are being asked to participate in funding/maintenance of the preserve. Mr. Rhoads to attend the September meeting in order to address the entire Board.
