1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Deputy Supervisor Bohnett on September 14, 2015 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Deputy Supervisor Bohnett, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Luckhardt and Trustee R. Prehn. Trustee R. Marion and Supervisor Marion were absent. Four other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Prehn moved, supported by Mrs. Luckhardt that the agenda be approved as presented.

6. Citizen Comments - Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. No citizen comments.
7. Supervisor's Report
 - a. Sherriff's Report- several traffic violations in July no major incidents.
 - b. Planning Commission to meet with the Township Board on October 6 to discuss the Master Plan.
 - c. Saline River Preserve- Jim Peter's and John Stanowski addressed the Board with a presentation on the Saline River Preserve & Wildlife Sanctuary Memorandum. The location of preserve would at the corner of Maple and Saline Milan Rd; approximately 1.50 acres is located in the township and rest in York Township with a total of 15.64 acres. Jim Peter's presented, explained and answered questions the Board had on the importance of the history that revolves around the plans for the preserve. John Stanowski explained that the cost to fund and maintain the project would not come from township or city dollars; it would be funds raised. There would be a committee of nine people representing the City of Saline, Saline Township, York Township and City of Milan that would be responsible for raising and maintaining the preserve. The committee would consist of people that are appointed by each entity. There are hopes of walking trails, which would connect to current trails going through the City of Saline and the cleaning up of the riverside so that canoes can travel between Saline and Milan. The Board is being asked to consider being a part of this project; further discussion at the October meeting.
