1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on November 9, 2015 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasure Luckhardt, Trustee Marion and Trustee Prehn. Two other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Prehn that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Prehn, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.

7. Supervisor's Report
 - a. Sheriff's Report- several traffic violations no major incidents, 68 calls in total.
 - b. Hack Road Bridge- construction to begin in 2016, date to be determined.
 - c. Arkona Road Bridge is completed and reopened in October.
 - d. Saline River Preserve – at this time Saline Township will not be committing to the Preserve. The Board will review the sanctuary agreement prior to the December meeting.
 - e. MTA confirmed that the change to start Regular Board meeting and Planning Commission meetings are in compliance. Both Boards will meet at 7PM starting in January 2016.
 - f. Hall Driveway- West side of driveway is washing away: Hammer Trucking to hall in material to correct the matter.

8. Trustee Report- Planning Commission met in November and potentially a Special Use Permit to be applied for. Potential request would be for a drywall storage facility. The Board has asked for more of a specific intent. It was also suggested that prior to the request going in front of the Planning Commission a second time said persons contract our township planner.
9. Zoning/Building Administrator- numerous calls and a few building permits and lot splits were applied for.

11. Township Hall Manager Report – grab bars to be added to restrooms.
12. Board Member Comment- Clerk Marion reported the election results. 259 voted, 137 voted no 122 voted yes for the school millage.
