## Regular Meeting March 11, 2013 Page 1 of 2

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on March 11, 2013 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Gordon, Trustee R. Marion & Trustee R. Prehn. Six other citizens were present.
3. Mr. R. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Prehn moved, supported by Mr. Robert Marion that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mrs. J. Gordon, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from February 11 regular meeting.
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
  - c. Approve Accounts Payable in the amount of \$3,554.10
  - d. Approve February payroll in the amount \$7,985.19
  - e. Approve Fire Protection – Operating \$99,959; Capital Improvements \$5,710; Township Percent 11.42%.
  - f. **Clerk Marion to pay any bills that are due prior to the April Regular Meeting in order to complete Fiscal Year 2012-2013.**
6. Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. Dan Cabage the township engineer reported that he will provide the Planning Commission the Gravel Pit Inspection Report at the April Meeting. A Saline Township resident brought his concerns to the Board with regards to the ability to burn house hold trash in a burn barrel. Currently the State has passed a law against such burning however there is some miss communication between DEQ & DNR as to what that law is. Supervisor Marion to meet with Fred Lucas, the township attorney to clarify this law. The Board may decide to put an Ordinance in place to avoid any future concern on the issue.
7. Supervisor's Report
  - a. Civil Infraction Ordinance- Supervisor Marion, Trustees Robert Marion and Robert Prehn to meet with Freed Lucas, the township attorney to clarify the minor changes that have been brought before the Board before acting on the Ordinance. More to follow at the April Regular Meeting.
  - b. Jean Kat Snips - Informed the Board on the nonprofit organization and its cause to spay and neuter cats. Kat Snips was in need of the Board to pass a resolution so that they could apply for a gaming license through the State of Michigan. A **MOTION** was made by Mr. Robert Prehn and supported by Mr. Robert Marion to pass said resolution. Ayes 5 Nays 0.

8. Trustees Report – Planning Commission to meet in April and again in May for a public hearing for the possibility of rezoning of a parcel.
9. Zoning/Building Administrator Reported on the falling down barns. There were twelve requests to remove said barns and only two residents have complied. Mr. Robert Marion to meet with Fred Lucas to see where the Township goes from here. Mr. Robert Marion and Supervisor Marion met with a group looking to purchase property for organic farming and cluster housing. At this point it was only an informational meeting for all.
10. Fireboard Report – No meeting in March.
11. Township Hall Manager Report- the Board is looking to have the inside of the hall painted, Paul Gumtow will obtain bids for the Board to review. Cement work out front will be addressed, weather permitting.
12. Board Member Comments – Mrs. Judy Gordon reported that taxes have been turned over to the county and we should be settled up by the end of the month.
13. The meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
