1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on August 12, 2013 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion Treasurer Gordon, and Trustee R. Marion. Trustee R. Prehn was absent. Three other citizen was present.
3. Ms. K. Marion led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mrs. Gordon that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. Robert. Marion moved, supported by Mrs. Gordon, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.

 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approve accounts payable for August in the amount of \$79,724.81
 - d. Approve Accounts payable from June 27-July 6 in the amount of \$7,325.03
 - e. Approve August payroll in the amount \$5,311.48
6. Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. No citizen comments.
7. Supervisor's Report
 - a. Art Trapp – Took photo of the Board for the Saline Business Directory.
 - b. Sheriff's Report- Several traffic violation however no major incidences.
 - c. Chuck Benedict/Painting- Painting of the basement is complete; upstairs to take place by the end of the year.
 - d. Brian Finkbeiner- Construction Exterior of Building- the front steps and side walk of the building to be replaced by the end of the month and possibly the new ramp before the November Election.
 - e. York Township/Maple Road – Saline and York Township working together to possibly share the responsibility of taking care of Maple Rd where the two townships meet.
 - f. Taxes- A **MOTION** was made by Mr. R Marion and supported by Mrs. J Gordon that to insure the township residents are treated equally as it relates to the collection of taxes the township to refund to taxpayers the portion of the administrative fee not collected equally from all residents from the summer 2013 bill and to send out revised tax bills to any resident who has not already paid. 8. Trustee Report- Planning Commission to have a public hearing at the October meeting to address adopting a conditional zoning ordinance.
9. Zoning/Building Administrator Report – A second notice is going out to all residences that have falling down building and have not complied. Notice to a Saline Township resident will be sent asking that compliance is met with regards to the maintaining of the grounds.

12. Board Member Comments- Clerk Marion mentioned that counts payable included \$42,490.25 to WCRD for Lime Stone Project and Brine; and to Saline Fire Department \$24,989.65 for Operating/Capital Improvements \$5,710.
