## **Regular Meeting March 12, 2012 Page 1 of 2**

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on March 12, 2012 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Gordon, Trustee R. Marion & Trustee R. Prehn. Three other citizens were present.
3. Mr. R. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Prehn moved, supported by Mr. Robert Marion that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mrs. J. Gordon, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from February 13 regular meeting.
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
  - c. Approve Accounts Payable in the amount of \$3,258.02
  - d. Approve February payroll in the amount \$8,441.18
  - e. Approve Fire Protection – Operating \$94,956; Capital Improvements \$5,710; Township Percent 11.42%.
  - f. Approve PA116 John Kohler
  - g. Spring Clean Up May 19, 2012 From 8:00 am – 2:00 pm.
  - h. Waive Participation in The River Raisin Watershed Council
6. Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. Mike Calegari wondered what happened to the culvert on Case Road; Supervisor Marion will follow up with Washtenaw County Road Commission.
7. Supervisor's Report
  - a. Rita Feital – a Resolution was passed to place a lien on the tax bill until the township has been reimbursed the money paid to clean up Rita's property on Mooreville Road. The motion was made by Mr. Robert Marion and supported by Mr. Robert Prehn; Ayes 5 Nays 0.
  - b. Cemetery Clean Up April 21 – Starting at 9:00am on Macon Road. Nancy Kohler will try and recruit members from 4H to help.
  - c. Dan Cabage will be working for Stan Tech starting in April. Dan to follow up with Mr. Clinks engineer in order for the plans to be submitted to the Planning Commission as soon as possible for approval.

8. Trustees Report – Planning Commission to meet in April to review Mr. Clink final plans for his request of a Special Use Permit. Farmer's Day to take place at the Washtenaw Farm Council Grounds March 22.
9. Zoning/Building Administrator Report – No current issues.
10. Fireboard Report – No meeting in March.
11. Township Hall Manager Report – Mr. Gumtow to work on the front step of the township hall, adding the address to the current sign out front, painting estimates for the township basement and boarding up the mausoleum at the Grass Road Cemetery.
12. Board Member Comments – Mr. J. Marion reminded the Board that Washtenaw County Road Commission will be at the April 9 meeting. Looking into having WCRC notify the Board as to when Paxton Oil has given the WCRC funds for maintaining Braun Road. Mr. J. Marion also looking into having the Manchester Yard service Saline Township; as well as looking into what happened to the Rural Division Group that was being put together to help with the follow through on maintaining the township roads. Mrs. K. Marion read the election results and notified the Board that any bills that are due in March will be paid prior to the April Meeting.
