## **Regular Meeting January 10, 2011 Page 1 of 2**

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on January 10, 2011 at 7:30 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Gordon, Trustee R. Prehn and R. Marion. Six other citizens were present.
3. Mr. R. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn, that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mrs. Gordon, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from December 13 regular meeting
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
  - c. Approve Accounts Payable in the amount of \$6,128.09
  - d. Approve January payroll in the amount of \$5,186.99
  - e. Third Quarter Operating Runs to Saline Fire Department in the amount of \$21,178.18
6. Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. No citizen comments.
7. Supervisor's Report
  - a. Maps – The Saline Township Board is considering replacing some of the older maps located at the township hall. Pricing and examples to follow at the February meeting.
  - b. Cemetery – Pricing yet to follow for the fence at Oak Hill Cemetery; possible that the fence will be taken down all together. The archways and gates will be refinished. Mr. Gumtow to supply current bid for a new door at the Union Cemetery.
  - c. Oak Park Subdivision – According to the township attorney, Fred Lucas, the township can override a subdivisions association rules. At this time there have not been any further complaints with regards to the barking dogs.
  - d. Sunday Alcohol – As the township stands there are no objections to serving alcohol on Sundays between the hours of 7 AM - 12 PM. Therefore no action will be taken at this time.

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8. Trustee Report – The Planning Commission is planning on placing a penalty within our Blight Ordinance; waiting on the township attorney and the township consultant to converse on the subject. It appears that the Home Occupation Ordinance will allow the Planning Commission to have a little latitude when making decisions that come before them. Still looking to delete the word “nuisance” from the Home Occupation Ordinance as well as checking to see if we currently have a Zoning Nuisance Ordinance. A letter has been sent to Mr. Clink asking for an update on his progress toward his Conditional Use Permit. Mr. Prehn checking with Don Pennington is seeing if the township has new maps coming per the last master plan being completed.
9. State Police – In October there were 18 calls, 6 of which were forced entry. November had 14 calls and December brought 12 calls, 8 of which were traffic violations.
10. No Zoning/Building Administrator Report.
11. Clerk Marion reported that the FHA members will be donating a stove to the township hall.
12. No Fireboard Report.
13. No Township Hall Report.
14. Board Member Comments- Mrs. Marion commented that the Election Committee will meet on February 11 at 9:30 AM for the public accuracy test. The Board will meet on February 22 at 10:00 AM to review the upcoming budget. Both meetings will take place at the Saline Township Hall. Board members commented that the State is thinking about changing our current due dates for taxes to July only.
15. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
