1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on February 14, 2011 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Deputy Gordon, Trustee R. Marion & Trustee R. Prehn. Mrs. Judy Gordon was absent. Three other citizens were present.
3. Mr. R. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
 - a. Approve minutes from January 10 regular meeting.
 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approve Accounts Payable in the amount of 4,754.60
 - d. Approve February payroll in the amount \$5,186.99
 - e. Approve current salary for the Fiscal Year of 2011-2012 to remain the same for the Saline Township Board.
 - f. March regular meeting will be held at 7:00PM to include approval for the final budget.
 - g. The Township Board will meet on February 22 at 10:00AM at the Township Hall to review the upcoming Budget.
6. Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. No citizen's comments.
7. Supervisor's Report
 - a. Board of Review will meet on March 14th from 3-9 and March 15th from 9-3.
 - b. WCRC will attend the April regular meeting to discuss their budget and plans for the upcoming year.
 - c. Lawn Bids will be accepted until April 1st. An ad will run in the Saline Reporter on February 24th, March 3rd and 10th.
 - d. Oak Park Snow – Currently the county has discovered that the developer of the last phase of the sub has never finished the road per the agreement with the county therefore the county will not be plowing that area. Once the road is complete it will than again be turned over to the county for the maintaining of snow removal. The township has spoken with the developer and he is aware of the situation. The township will continue to converse with the developer. It is suggested that the homeowners contact the developer with their concerns.

8. Trustees reported that there were 20 homes sold in Saline Township last year. Mr. Prehn has taken the time to welcome several of these new residences to our township. The February Planning Commission meeting was cancelled due to weather, the next meeting will be held in April. Mr. Prehn attended the meeting that Saline Schools held for the public in order to inform them about the millage proposal on the February ballot. Mr. Prehn also attended the Tim Walburg conference however there wasn't much ground covered therefore nothing to report. The master plan is still not completed so at this point the township may move forward with the new consultant in order to complete it. This matter will be taken up with the township attorney prior to any action being taken.
9. No Zoning/Building Administrator
10. Fireboard Report – Working on upcoming budget. A small raise was given to the firefighters. Possible committee to be formed to discuss future plans, such as a possible substation in Lodi Township as one example.
11. Township Hall Manager Report – The Town Hall clock is not working. Cemetery clean up will be held April 16th. Spring clean up will be held either on May 14th or the May 21st. Confirmation to follow at next meeting. Dates will be posted on the web site.
12. Board Member Comments – The Township will pay for the work completed at a home located on Mooreville Road; contractor was hired by the township. The homeowner will be offered a payment plan otherwise a lien will be placed on the property to insure payment. Dan Cabage attended the meeting to inform the board that the Washtenaw County GIS information on the gravel pits will be provided shortly. He will also be providing the Board, Planning Commission and Mr. Clink information on soil guidelines for his property located on Michigan Ave.
13. The meeting adjourned at 8:05 pm.
