Regular Meeting

May 9, 2011

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1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on May 9, 2011 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Gordon, Trustees R. Prehn and R. Marion. Three other citizens were present.
3. Mr. R. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Prehn moved, supported by Mr. R. Marion, that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
 - a. Approve minutes from April 11 regular meeting
 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approve Accounts Payable in the amount of \$5,705.14
 - d. Approve Payroll for May in the amount of \$ 5,186.99
 - e. Assessing to Washtenaw County Equalization in the amount of \$15,000.
6. Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. No comments.
7. Supervisor Marion commented on the following:
 - a. Urban County Participation – The board will be checking with surrounding townships as to the logistics of this program. Further discussion at the June 13th meeting to follow.
 - b. Washtenaw County Transportation Study/The Ride – Representatives for this study presented the board with a brief explanation on how this program can help the residents of Saline Township along with the surrounding areas. This program is currently on a 30 year plan. Currently the township is being asked to send one representative to attend meetings so that the Township Board can make an informed decision on whether or not to opt out of the program. Funding for this program would consist of placing a millage on a ballot in which the residents would vote on. Purpose of the program is to offer a few additional transportation options for the residents. Further discussion at the June 14th meeting to follow.
 - c. Township Roads - Mike Callegari informed the board that the Road Committee is looking to spend about \$90,000 on this year's program and hopes to cover about 10,600 feet of road. Proposal for work to go in front of the Board for approval. Brine should be going down in the township soon. Clarification was made to one township resident that at this time no resident is paying tax dollars to WCRC. Township looking to have more than one grader working in the township at any given time, meeting with WCRC possibly to take place with regards to this matter.

12. Board Member Comments – Treasure Gordon reported that the township is settled up with the county. Mrs. Gordon will be renewing her Notary ability.
