

August 09, 2010

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on August 9, 2010 at 7:30PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Gordon and Trustee R. Marion. Trustee R. Prehn was absent. Five other citizens were present.
3. Mrs. Marion led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. Robert Marion moved, supported by Mrs. Judy Gordon that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. Robert Marion moved, supported by Mrs. Judy Gordon that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from the July 12 regular meeting.
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report.
  - c. Approve Accounts Payable in the amount of \$4,231.05.
  - d. Approve Accounts payable in the amount of \$5,312.58 from July1, 2010 - July 12, 2010.
  - e. Approve Payroll for August in the amount of \$5,186.99.
  - f. Approve First Quarter Saline Fire Department Operating in the amount of \$21,178.18 and Capital Improvements in the amount of \$5,825.
6. Citizens were offered a chance to address the Board regarding items not already on the agenda. Two citizens addressed the board with regards to Dakota Oil and the work they're doing off of Braun Road. The township board has asked the citizens to inform the Township

Board, Dakota Oil, and WCRC if Braun Road starts to take on additional wear due to the high traffic of large trucks employed by Dakota Oil.

7. Supervisor Marion commented on the following:
  - a. FEMA - Dan Cabage is working on getting FEMA any information required by the township.
  - b. Civil Infractions that are handed out to township residents will have a \$50 fee.
  - c. Mark Hinckley attended the meeting to express his concern with regards to the condition of Arkona Road (mail delivery was denied and the flow of water has changed) in which his residence is located. Mr. Hinckley along with the WCRC and Supervisor Marion met to try and determine what action should be taken. Supervisor Marion will be meeting with WCRC to try and resolve this issue as soon as possible.
  - d. Ann Arbor Transportation - currently Saline Township does not have a transportation service available to the residents.
  - e. Supervisor Marion and Trustee Marion will not be at the September meeting.
8. State Police - no report.
9. Clerk Marion reported that the budget would not need to be amended due to the one time collected income from Dakota Oil. Three new tables will be purchased. Election equipment will be stored at the township. Voting results were read to the public.
10. Trustees Report - A public hearing will be held on August 31st to discuss the Conditional Use Permit for Kevin Clink.
11. Zoning/Building Administrator reported that the township will be hiring a company to clean the yard that belongs to Rita Feitel located on Mooreville Road. The police department will be notified so that they

are in attendance. The cost of this will place a lien on the property and an interest of 7% per year will be charged until the township is reimbursed.

12. Fireboard Report - no report.

13. Township Hall Manager Report - No report.

14. Board Member Comments - Judy Gordon wanted to verify the date (July of 2011) in which the township will be attending the tax tribunal for the property located on Michigan Ave owned by Saline Ventures LLC. Robert Marion was wondering where we were at with the estimate needed for the work at Oak Hill Cemetery; there should be information by the September meeting.
