10. Motion by Mrs. Gordon, supported by Mr. Bohnett, to accept the new Dumping Ordinance as presented. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Baldus, Bohnett, Gordon, and R. Marion. Nays: None. Absent: J. Marion. Ordinance Passed.

12. Zoning/Building Administrator reported Township Attorney is mailing letters to residents that are not following registered vehicle policy.
13. No Fireboard Meeting report.
14. Township Hall Manager reported that another basement window needs replacement. Weeds have been sprayed.
15. Mrs. Gordon commented that she has settled with the County. Mr. R. Marion spoke that there is movement in Lansing to change procedures and to possible have a Bill that will take away Township voting, tax collection and assessing. All would be happening at the County level in effect would hurt Townships. Mr. Cabage, Township Engineer, spoke briefly regarding Austin Commons II. He will be contacting MDEQ to see where is the issues are at. Jessica Ping-Mills was present and spoke briefly on current Washtenaw County issues. Jessica would like to see an expansion of County Road Commissioner seats to 5 versus 3. She has been campaigning for Mr. Carl Girbach. County is still working on balancing the budgets.
