1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on May 14, 2018 at 7:00PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Treasurer Luckhardt, Clerk Marion, Trustees R. Marion & Trustee R. Prehn. Five other citizens were present.
3. Mr. R. Prehn led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Mr. Robert Marion moved, supported by Mr. R. Prehn that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
