1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on October 14, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Zink and Trustee R. Marion and Trustee Hammond. Three other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Hammond led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond that the agenda be approved as presented. Ayes 5 Nays 0
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond, that the consent agenda be approved as presented. Ayes 5 Nays 0
 - a. Approve minutes from the September 9th regular meeting.
 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approve Accounts Payable for October in the amount of \$17,055.67
 - d. Approve October payroll in the amount \$7,228.02
 - e. Approve second quarterly payment to SAFD for operating in the amount of \$33,681.63
 - f. Approve second payment to WCRC in the amount of \$63,161.60 for brine/limestone project.
6. Citizen Comments – a residents addressed the Board regarding the sidewalk that is proposed to run from Huntington Woods across her property and into the city: currently there has been some progress with the HOA regarding the liability for the sidewalk: pre the resident it has been determined that the property to the north of her is still contaminated and that it will take another 15 years to hopefully have the land clear of contamination, the worry is once the ground is disturbed that the contamination will spread. A **MOTION** was made by Mr. Tom Hammond and supported by Mr. R Marion to have the township attorney send a letter to who he feels necessary expressing the townships concerns if the sidewalk is constructed. The township will be adding additional language to the current special use permits for KBK & Clink landscaping regarding millings. A public hearing will take place on December 1 for David Finkbeiner's regarding the milling currently on his property.
10. Fireboard Report – the current chief will be retiring next year so a committee will be formed for the process for the hiring of a one.
