Trustee's Report- Mr. Hammond reported that a public hearing will take place July 6 to discuss the Board making all final approvals on special use permits. The Planning Commission approved Clink Landscaping's modified special use permit allowing 2000 yards of bark to be stored on site. Concern has been made regarding tress obstructing the intersection at Macon & Arkona, WCRC will be looking into.
