1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on June 8, 2022 at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Zink, Trustee R. Marion and Trustee Hammond. Six other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Hammond led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond that the agenda be approved.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
 - a. Approve minutes from May 11th regular meeting.
 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approval payroll for June in the amount of \$7,617.55
 - d. Approval accounts payable in June in the amount of \$20,117.22
 - e. Approve payment in the amount of \$20,000 to Washtenaw County Equalization for assessing, 2022-2023.
6. Citizen Comments -Karl Barr running for Judge in the 14A District Ct introduced himself to the residence, answered questions. Questions were asked about the Greeves property being annexed in the City of Saline, at this time the Township Board has no comment, we have not been formally presented with a proposal to comment on. The recycling and trash procedures at Andelina Farms is currently unknown, more to follow after the next progress meeting. The Township had no comment on Solar Companies speaking directly to residents.

 - b. Andelina Farms- a compliant was made from a nearby resident regarding the trash in the fence area, to be addressed at the next progress meeting.

 - d. Amend Budget to add ARPA as an expense- a MOTION was made by Mr. Hammond and supported by Mr. R. Marion to add the ARPA as an expense. Ayes 5 Nays 0
 - e. Amend Budget Payroll- a MOTION was made by Mr. Hammond and supported by Mr. R Marion to pay the deputies when needed an hourly rate of \$20 an hour adding a total expense of \$5,000 to the budget. Ayes 5 Nays 0
 - f. Nuisance Ordinance- to be addressed at the July meeting.
 - g. Saline Fire Department ARPA- looking for additional funds, to be discussed at the July meeting.

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8. Trustee's Report- additional information to be provide for the Clink application. The master plan was reviewed with no changes, going in front of the Board next for approval. Zoning Ordinance still under review before being proposed for approval. County mowing along the roadsides. Next meeting August 2.

9. Zoning/Building Administrator Report – 23 acres on Mooreville Rd being reviewed for a possible development consisting of 10 homes.
