## **Regular Meeting July 13, 2022 Page 1 of 2**

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on July 13, 2022 at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Clerk Marion, Treasurer Zink, Trustee R. Marion and Trustee Hammond. Nine other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Hammond led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond that the agenda be approved.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from June 8<sup>th</sup> regular meeting.
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
  - c. Approval payroll for July in the amount of \$7,617.55
  - d. Approval accounts payable in July in the amount of \$9,502.08
  - e. WCRC first payment in the amount of \$65,859.60 for the limestone project/brine.
6. Citizen Comments – what prompted the nuisance ordinance- Mr. R. Marion said the township needed an ordinance that was more specific in order to enforce. Supervisor Marion to follow up with WCRC regarding when the brine will be put down. Mitch King introduced himself to the Board/residence, he and a couple other colleagues will be new contact for Invenergy.
7. Supervisor's Report
  - a. Sheriff's Report- no major incidents.
  - b. Andelina Farms- current bond being held is 3.5 million, MI Homes would like most of that released. Dan Cabbage presented a proposed amount of \$475,000 of the bond to be held back for items not completed. The Board will review the proposal and vote on at the August meeting. The traffic light at Austin and Michigan seems to have a lot of back-ups so MDOT will be reviewing the current traffic situation and possibly adjust the timing of the light.
  - c. Nuisance Ordinance- a MOTION was made by Mr. Tom Hammond and supported by Mr. R. Marion to adopt the more specific nuisance ordinance subject to the language regarding swimming pools being stricken and active farmland properties being exempt from section 7 regarding cutting of grass/weeds. Ayes 5 Nays 0
  - d. Saline Fire Department ARPA- SAFD is requesting the township contribute \$33,030 which is 25% of the total of \$131,120, toward concrete repair, turnout gear and SCBA masks. Prior to a vote attorney Fred Lucas is going to review the townships agreement with SAFD.
