**Regular Meeting**  
**August 10, 2022**  
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1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on August 10, 2022 at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Treasurer Zink, Trustee R. Marion and Trustee Hammond. Clerk Marion was absentee. Seven other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Hammond led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond that the agenda be approved.
5. Mrs. Zink moved, supported by Mr. Hammond, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from July 13<sup>th</sup> regular meeting.
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
  - c. Approval payroll for August in the amount of \$7,617.55
  - d. Approval accounts payable in August in the amount of \$9,2007
  - e. Approve First Quarter Operating in the amount of \$48,505.87 and Capital Improvements in the amount of \$8.332.
6. Citizen Comments – Brandon guest from MI Homes requested to be added to the agenda, MOTION made by Mr. R. Marion and supported by Mr. Hammond to added MI Homes to the agenda, under Supervisor report.
7. Supervisor's Report
  - a. Sheriff's Report- no major incidents.
  - b. *Andelina Farms- Brandon from M/I Homes informed us of needing approval from the board to continue and to pave phase II and III. Hammond informed the board that the Planning Commission approved this request from M/I Homes the night before (August 9, 2022). Planning Commission requested that the crosswalk does not go through Milkey property. M/I Homes agrees with this request. Motion made by Zink for Andelina Farms to continue Phase II and III; supported by Hammond. No discussion. Roll Call Vote: Ayes 4 Nays 0 Clerk Marion was absent. Dan Cabage reported on the following: Light on Austin Rd. overseen by MDOT needs to be adjusted due to backups. M/I Homes to a request a sight visit from MDOT traffic officer. Discussed bypass lane on US-12 entrance part of Phase I and II. MDOT will need to approve entrance west of Marion Rd. on US-12. Dan recommended and advised that the township board and M/I Homes have a meeting with MDOT. Dan C. went over the performance guarantee bond for M/I Homes. Dan recommends reducing the bond to \$600,000. Board discussed and agreed to vote on the Performance Guarantee Bond at the next meeting (September 14, 2022).*
  - c. Saline Fire Department additional funds- MOTION was made by Mr. R. Marion and supported by Mr. Hammond to contribute the additional funds at our 11.11% Ayes 4 Nays 0 Clerk Marion was absent.
  - d. Approve the L-4029 tax rate 2022- MOTION was made by Mr. Hammond and supported by Mr. R. Marion to approve the 2022- tax rate. Ayes 4 Nays 0 Clerk Marion was absent.
  - e. *J. Marion recommended Levi Smith to be appointed on the Planning Commission Board. Motion made by R. Marion; Hammond supported; Vote: Aye- unanimously.*

8. Trustee's Report- *Planning Commission last night approved to Phase I: Cleanup of pond, move dirt, screen topsoil. There is to be no removal of Phase I. Per Fred for any Phases beyond Phase I it is recommended that Clink has a impose reclamation (bond money). Bill for tree trimming was received by the board.*
9. Zoning/Building Administrator Report – *Working on 3 letters to be sent out to property owners for cleanup of their property*
10. No Fireboard Report
11. Inspector/Chairperson Wages- MOTION was made by Mrs. Zink and supported by Mr. Hammond to increase the election inspector's wages to \$16.00 an hour and the chairperson to \$18.00 an hour. Ayes 4 Nays 4 Clerk Marion was absent
12. Township Hall Manager Report- bee issue taken care of August 4
13. No Board Member Comments
14. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
