## **Regular Meeting January 11, 2023 Page 1 of 2**

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on January 11 ,2023 at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Treasurer Zink, Clerk Marion, Trustee R. Marion and Trustee Hammond. Four other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Hammond led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond that the agenda be approved.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from December 14<sup>th</sup> regular meeting.
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
  - c. Approval payroll for January in the amount of \$7,617.55
  - d. Approval accounts payable in January in the amount \$41,240.73
  - e. Decline participation with the River Raisin Watershed

7. Supervisor's Report
  - a. Sheriff's Report- no major incidents.
  - b. Andelina Farms- Dan Cabage to follow up with MDOT regarding a passing lane on US 12 and adjusting the timing of the light at Austin Rd and US12.
  - c. Planning Commission/Zoning Board of Appeals Reappointment- a MOTION was made by Mr. R. Marion and supported by Mr. Hammond to reappoint Tim Malinczak and Jennifer Zink to the Zoning Board of Appeal and Gary Luckhardt as Chairperson to the Planning Commission. Ayes 5 Nay 0
  - d. 425 City of Saline- Macon Rd-the township has made a counteroffer of a 25-year term at 1 mill, will further discussion about additional language they may want added. At this time the Board is waiting to hear back from the city.

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8. Trustee's Report- No January meeting, next meeting/public meeting is February 7 to discuss the special use permit that Dan Boswell has applied for.
9. Zoning/Building Administrator Report – address have been finished for Andelina Farms. Final letter to go out to those residents who are in violation of the Blight Ordinance. These letters will allow the residents to respond within 14 days after that a fine/legal actions will be taken.
10. Fireboard Report- currently the fire department is not a separate entity and is looking to hold a position of a Fire Board with Authority. Language has been drafted for a new agreement, at this point the agreement is still in discussion with legal counsel.
11. No Township Hall Manager Report
12. Board Member Comments- Clerk Marion informed the Board that she and Treasurer Zink and Deputy Rothfuss will began to sort through the paperwork that was turned over from the pervious Planning Commission secretary, the three Board members will be paid \$20 an hour. It was decided not to rent the hall on a regular basis for a dance class; such a commitment would limit the use for Board meeting if necessary. Clerk Marion reminded the Board that the budget will need to be reviewed for 2023-2024 fiscal year and if a pay raise is to take place it needs to happen at the February meeting. A MOTION was made by Treasurer Zink and supported by Mr. R Marion to adopt the 2023 Poverty Exemption guild lines. Ayes 5 Nays 0
