## **Regular Meeting February 8, 2023 Page 1 of 2**

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on February 8, 2023 at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Treasurer Zink, Clerk Marion and Trustee R. Marion. Trustee Hammond was absent. Four other citizens were present.
3. Clerk Marion led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R Marion moved, supported by Mrs. Zink that the agenda be approved.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mrs. Zink, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.

At this time the township planner, attorney and Board are looking to put language in place regarding batterie storage facilities, currently the ordinance would not allow such a project.
