**Regular Meeting
August 9, 2023
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1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on August 9, 2023 at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Treasurer Zink, Clerk Marion, Trustee Hammond, and Trustee R. Marion. Four other citizens were present.
3. Mr. Hammond led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond that the agenda be approved.
5. Mr. R. Marion moved, supported by Mr. Hammond, that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
 - a. Approve minutes from the July14 meeting.
 - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
 - c. Approve Accounts Payable for August in the amount of \$29,918.21
 - d. Approval payroll for August in the amount of \$8,775.89
 - e. Saline Fire Department First Quarter Payment operating \$52,885 capital improvements \$8,482.50
 - f. WCRC Limestone Project in the amount of \$106,796.50
6. Citizen Comments- representatives from Jupiter updated the Board: approximate revenue for the township 1.5 million and 15 million for the local and county schools: life time of the project is 30 years: construction time approximately 1 year, 50 employees after completion limited employees for maintenance: the project will be owned and operated by Jupiter: invited the Board to walk the site and meet with the Fire Chief: the projects source will be limited to electricity only.
7. Supervisor's Report
 - a. Sheriff's Report- no major incidents.
 - b. Andelina Farms- left turn lane on Michigan Ave to be shortened: phase III is moving forward: two drainage issues being addressed: waiting on MDOT and WCRC to approve a time change for light at the intersection of Michigan Ave and Austin Rd
 - c. Approval L-4029 – a MOTION was made by Trustee Marion and supported by Trustee Hammond to approve the 2023 rates. Ayes 5 Nays 0

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8. Trustee's Report- the batterie storage (Jupiter) was the topic of discussion, looks like the Board may recommend a 600-foot set back.
9. Zoning/Building Administrator Report – they Board to legally move forward with residents who have received three notice to comply with the Blight Ordinance and have not responded. ITC/DTE looking to expand 20 feet if the Jupiter project moves forward.

11. Township Hall Manager Report- Supervisor Marion to have the cemeteries cleaned up where overgrown brush/bushes have taken over. A cement slab to be poured in front of the building out back.
