The board was informed that the state is putting in affect eminent domain on energy facilities, solar and wind projects, which will be in effect in a year. The township attorney discussed some of the states setbacks which differ from the draft ordinance. He also discussed some of the issues with fire prevention and wether we can require different solutions for fire prevention. At 7:20 p.m a motion was made by Hammond to open the public hearing for battery energy storage ordinance support by Smith. A spokesperson from Jupiter brought up the issue they have with the townships setback and would like us to move forward with a solution that works for them.
